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6 Family Onsite Instruction Opt-Out Form

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9 A family who does not want their student to receive instruction and educational services onsite at the  
10 school may request to have instruction completed offsite and/or online by completing this form.

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12 Students of families opting out of onsite instruction at the school facility shall receive offsite, online, and  
13 proficiency-based instruction, or any combination of the foregoing at the discretion of the School District  
14 in accordance with District Policy 1906. School District staff shall arrange for any combination of  
15 physical instructional packets, virtual or electronic based course meetings and assignments, self-directed  
16 or parent/guardian-assisted learning opportunities, and other educational efforts available to staff and  
17 students that can be relied upon for grade or credit in order to satisfy the minimum aggregate number of  
18 hours or determination of proficiency for the requesting student. Students determined to be proficient in  
19 one or more courses of the district shall be incorporated in the School District’s calculation of ANB, with  
20 such ANB fraction to be converted to an hourly equivalent based on the hours of instruction ordinarily  
21 provided for the content over which the student has demonstrated proficiency.

27 offsite location and/or for the duration of the declared public health emergency in a manner consistent  
28 with the methods identified by the School District.

30 I understand my student is expected to complete all assigned work and return it to the teacher in order to  
31 receive credit toward a grade to be considered for promotion or credit and in accordance with Policy  
32 1902, if applicable. I further understand that failure to complete work assigned may result in a  
33 determination that my student will be retained or otherwise not earn credit.

35 By signing I understand that my child is allowed to trial online instruction for an initial two (2) weeks  
36 after which I will be committing to an entire mid-quarter of online instruction (4.5 weeks). Request for  
37 online/remote learning will be in effect until I provide notice to the District during and/or following the  
38 initial two (2) week trial and/or notice of returning to onsite instruction prior to the end of the upcoming  
39 mid-term. Students may only return to onsite/in-person instruction at a mid-term and/or end of the  
40 quarter.

42 Requests for offsite/remote learning to start the 2020-2021 school year are due to the District office by  
43 Friday August 14<sup>th</sup> by 3:00pm.
